

Cookie Policy

What are cookies?

Cookies are small, simple text files that are placed on your computer's hard drive when you visit a web page. These cookies can help optimize your visit to the website. For example, your preferences are remembered so that we only show you information that is of interest to you. Another advantage is that you do not have to log in or fill in the same information every time you visit a certain website.

Why are we informing you about the use of cookies?

On Tuesday, June 5, 2012 the amended Telecommunications Act entered into force in the Netherlands. This means, among other things, that certain cookies may only be placed with the explicit consent of the internet user. Therefore we let you know that our website uses cookies and what the reason for this is.

Google Analystics

Cookies can also be used to track visitor statistics. We use Google Analytics to gain insight into the behavior of visitors on our website. On the basis of this data, we gain insight into the surfing and visiting behavior of our visitors and we can optimize our website for you where possible. The information that Google collects is anonymized as much as possible. Your IP address will not be provided.

Accepting or refusing cookies

You can decide for yourself whether to accept or refuse cookies. Most browsers are set up to accept cookies, but you can usually change the settings of your browser so that cookies are refused. You will have to adjust this for each browser and for each computer.

Explanation about changing the settings can be found in the 'help function' of your browser:

- Google Chrome;
- Internet Explorer;
- Mozilla Firefox;
- Apple Safari

Note: it is possible that some functions and services, on our and other websites, do not function properly if cookies are disabled in your browser.
